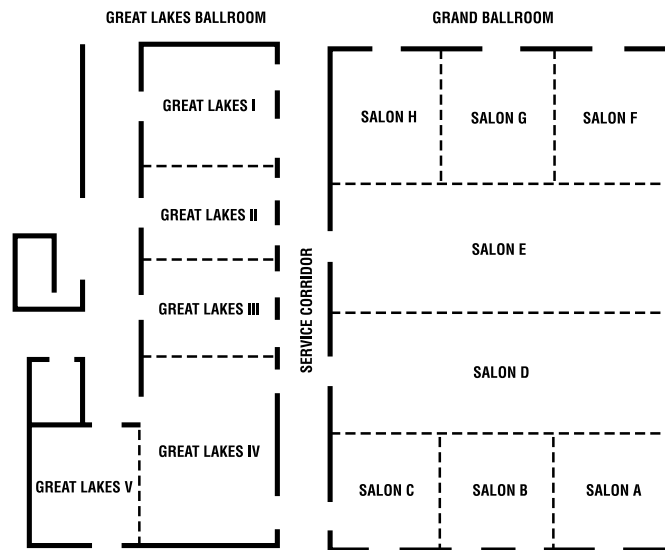

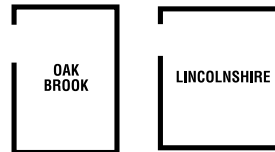




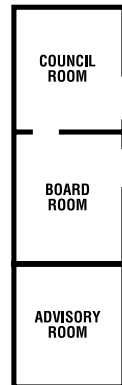
FLOOR PLAN



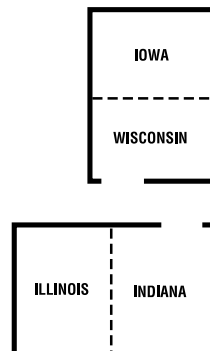
SECOND FLOOR

CULINARY CREATIVITY

Our overall culinary goal at the Lincolnshire Marriott Resort is to stay dedicated to the simplicity of classic, Midwestern fare zeroing in on seasonal, locally-sourced and farm fresh ingredients.

JOE PLUCINSKI - EXECUTIVE CHEF AT THE LINCOLNSHIRE MARRIOTT RESORT

Joe Plucinski is no stranger to Midwestern cuisine. As Executive Chef, his goal is straightforward: execute simple, chef-crafted food, while focusing on local products from area farmers and producers. With the emphasis on seasonal food from farm to table, Chef Joe Plucinski's Midwestern surroundings play a major role in the resort's overall culinary vision. Specifically in regards to the flavorsome tastes integrated into the resort's restaurant and customized event menus as well as the creative food and beverage presentation.

THE HONEY BEES

The "buzz" throughout the resort is from our bee hives located just yards off of the Crane's Landing Golf Course. Plentiful honey extractions have allowed us to craft our own resort beer: Marriott's Honey Wheat, on tap in the Lobby Bar. The natural honey is used in our kitchen sweet treats and is on sale in the Lobby Shop. Our ambition is to manufacture enough honey so that we will no longer have to purchase any. One million bees work for us in a collaborative, Marriott-effort to support the Children's Miracle Network Foundation and Chicago's Children's Memorial Hospital.

LINCOLNSHIRE MARRIOTT WINEMAKING

Fermented juice accrued from one of our client events is currently aging in oak barrels. This summer we will release the first of our two wines, Alborino. In preliminary testing's we found this white wine to be very aromatic with scents of almonds, apples, peaches and citrus.

LINCOLNSHIRE MARRIOTT CHEESEMAKING

Recently, the culinary team partnered with master cheese maker Mark Heise of Beechwood cheese in Wisconsin. In addition to producing over 4,000 pounds of cheese, the partnership has created a unique opportunity for Marriott to fully understand the passion of our local producers, learn the art of cheese making and serve a featured cheese exclusively available at the resort.

SELF-SUFFICIENT FARMING

The culinary team has taken a huge step towards self sufficiency in the efforts to grow their own produce. The resort has dedicated an entire acre to growing fresh vegetables and greens. Based on preliminary numbers, we are anticipating 5,000 pounds of produce to be harvested this year alone.

FUTURE INITIATIVES

- A partnership with local distillery to produce whisky
- The planting of thirty Asian pear trees which will bear fruit in 2013

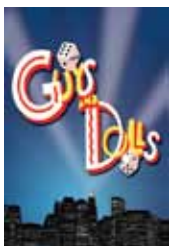

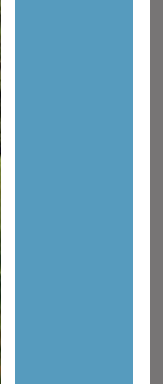
