Beaches

Observation Deck - Burj Khalifa

Situated on the 124th floor of the tallest building in the world, the Burj Khalifa, it offers some of the most amazing views of the Dubai Skyline, from its uniquely positioned location. Standing 442 meters tall, it is recognized as the highest outdoor observation deck in the world.

Shopping

Dubai arguably has some of the best retail malls in the world with designer malls and unique themed malls springing up all the time. One of the newest to the Dubai scene is the Dubai Mall, situated at the base of the Burj Khalifa. Offering just about every name brand available, it also houses the Dubai Aquarium and Underwater Zoo, an indoor ice-skating rink, a family entertainment zone, and the Dubai Fountain with its amazing dancing fountain.

Ski Dubai

For a really innovative project, visitors can experience a bit of the Alpine in the middle of the desert at Ski Dubai, where great skiing, snowboarding, and a children's ice park are available.

Souks in Dubai

Tour Dubai by Air

Visitors with a head for heights and a weakness for the dramatic, can enjoy the excitement of a helicopter tour over the city. Alternatively, visitors can enjoy city or desert tours in a fixed-wing aircraft or even hot air balloons.

Tour Dubai by Sea (Dhow Cruises)

A fascinating way to see Dubai is by sea. You sail along the Arabian Gulf and admire the coastline and palaces, hotels and beaches. Many of the tours are in traditional wooden dhow or Abras (the traditional water taxi) which take you on a short journey across the waterway, providing a fascinating glimpse of Dubai's trading heritage.

Water Park Fun

Located within Atlantis is AquaVenture, the largest water park in the Middle East region. This 42 acre park houses speedslides, rivers, rapids, luscious gardens, a private beach, and a children's playground. Guests can also visit Dolphin Bay, where they can interact with these amazingly gentle creatures.

Situated in between the famous Burj Al Arab v Star hotel, and the Jumeirah Beach Hotel, is the fantastic Wild Wadi Water Park. Great for all ages, this Middle Eastern themed park, offers over 30 rides and attractions to enjoy.
