Butter Chicken

Butter chicken or Murgh Makhani is an Indian dish, popular all over the world. The origins of butter chicken can be traced back to Delhi, during the period of Mughal Empire. According to a documentary by the Discovery Channel, butter chicken recipe was invented by a person working in the kitchen staff of a famous restaurant called Moti Mahal located in Daryaganj, the central region of Delhi.

Lamb Rogan Josh

Rogan josh (or roghan josh) is an aromatic lamb dish hailing from Kashmir and is quite popular in India, Pakistan, Singapore and the United Kingdom. Rogan means oil in Persian, while josh means heat, hot, boiling, or passionate. Rogan josh thus means cooked in oil at intense heat. Another interpretation of the name rogan josh is derived from the word rogan meaning colour and josh meaning passion, hot or red.

Thai Green Vegetable Curry

Traditional Thai cooking methods were stewing and baking, or grilling. Chillies were introduced to Thai cooking during the late 1600s by Portuguese missionaries who had acquired a taste for them while serving in South America. Thais were very adept at "Siameseising" foreign cooking methods, and substituting ingredients. Today's classic Thai cuisine employs a perfect balance between sweet, salt and chilli with each element of the dish carefully considered for a harmony of flavours.
