



Frankfurt City- Low Emission Zone

As of the 1st of October, 2008 a Low Emission Zone has been introduced in Frankfurt. This comprises the city centre and all areas within the beltway. From west it is bounded by the A5, at the south by the A3 and from east and north by the A661. Traffic restrictions apply within this zone in order to permanently improve the air quality. The **Frankfurt Marriott Hotel** is located within this zone and therefore only accessible for 'clean vehicles'

What does it mean for you?

The regulations regarding the Low Emission Zone will apply for all Frankfurt residents and visitors, also those from abroad. This is why you should inform yourself about the regulations at your destination before your departure. As a tourist with an automobile you will require a fine particles sticker, in order to be permitted to drive in the Low Emission Zone. Find out first which pollutant group your vehicle belongs to. This influences which fine particles sticker you will receive.



What kind of stickers are there?

The round, coloured stickers in red, yellow and green indicate the pollution categories 2, 3 and 4. Pollution category 1 is reserved for vehicles with especially high pollution levels.



They don't get a sticker. For example, these vehicles are diesel vehicles classified as Euro I and worse as well as petrol vehicles without any or with an unregulated catalytic converter.



How do I get a sticker?

If you live abroad, you can order a sticker under:

After receiving the sticker, please attach it to the interior windscreen on the right-hand (passenger) side. The stickers are valid throughout Germany and cost approximately 29,90 Euro.

Entering the Low Emission Zone without a sticker

You are only allowed to travel in the Low Emission Zone without a sticker if you have a certificate of exemption. Cars stopped without this mandatory sticker will be fined.
