

## MODERNIZATION AT THE AIRPORT GOES ON - COURTYARD BY MARRIOTT INVESTS 1.5 MILLION EURO FOR RENOVATION

Hamburg / Fuhlsbüttel, April 2010. New terminal with 70 check-in desks, 4.500 sqm Airport-Plaza, 12.000 car parking lots and S-Bahn connection – the biggest extension steps up to now are finished finally. However the modernization goes on. Now the renowned Airport Hotel Courtyard by Marriott starts with its fundamental modernization of guest rooms and restaurant. General Manager Ravindra K. Ahuja is going to invest 1.5 million Euro into the charming 4 stars superior hotel until May. “In Mai when we present our renovated hotel we will lead the ranking of renovated airport hotels”, the engaged hotelier says. He has been operated the hotel for 16 years and five years ago the hotel joined the international Marriott group.

Discrete, soundless and unnoticed from the guests - that is the way the architects Morgenstern from Dresden carry out the renovations. Except for the suites most guest rooms get new furniture, modern technical equipment and a cosy light concept. “We combine fresh and warm colours to ameliorate the living ambience remarkable”, Carolin Stein from Morgenstern says. She sets courses at the red or rather yellow dotted carpet which is just a few month old. The renovation includes light yellow walls, matt brazen LED lamps as well as the black cherry optic of the new writing desks, night tables and wardrobes with mirror door. The red leather armchairs and the chairs for the writing desk are also new. All washing basins and armatures in the marble bathrooms will be changed and a shower door made of glass will be installed. All the rooms get a flat screen entertainment system with internet, wake-up call and a selection of videos, CD’s and radio. Even the bill is visible on TV.
