**ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY**

Lingfield Park Marriott Hotel & Country Club recognises its responsibility to respect the environment and is committed to ensuring that its business activities are effectively managed to reduce environmental impact and to comply with all statutory regulations concerning the environment.

In pursuit of our business objectives we will actively seek to reduce the consumption of energy, raw materials and production of waste and harmful emissions resulting from our activities.

We believe that everyone has a duty of care towards the environment and it is our intention to ensure that all of our management and staff are aware of their responsibility and are committed to reducing the consumption of utilities and the production of waste through good housekeeping practices.

We will continue to conduct internal environmental reviews on an annual basis to assess our progress towards improved environmental performance and achievement of targeted reductions.

**DEMONSTRATING OUR COMMITMENT**

Lingfield Park Marriott Hotel & Country Club will be enrolled with the Hospitable Climates Programme, a joint initiative between the HCIMA and the Carbon Trust to assist the hospitality industry to identify ways of improving energy efficiency and reducing carbon emissions.

The Carbon Trust and other organizations will carry out energy efficiency surveys and a list of recommendations to assist in our carbon reduction programme. Other initiatives can be summarized as follows:

- Utility usage is recorded on a monthly basis by the hotel and monitored for trends and used as a measurement tool to benchmark success/reduce unnecessary consumption.
- Energy Efficient compact fluorescent lamps are used in the hotel where possible. The hotel will replace dichroic lamps with compact fluorescent or LED alternatives where possible.
- Lighting is turned off in unoccupied back of house areas where possible either by sensor, time clock or staff awareness.
- Room controllers are installed in guest bedrooms that provide energy saving by activating the Air Conditioning and lighting only when a guest occupies the room.
- The hotel has registered with the Environment Agency as Hazardous Waste Producers (Fluorescent tubes, filters and batteries)
- A survey on the consumption of water at Lingfield Park will be conducted. We will continue to reduce the volumes of water used by the introduction of fittings and equipment that eliminates excessive use of this resource.
- Waste management contracts have been instigated that will see the implementation of recycling re-usable materials such as glass, paper and cardboard.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL ACTION PLAN 2010**

Our objectives for 2010 can be summarized as follows:

- Achieve a reduction of waste through increased recycling
- Achieve a reduction of electricity consumption through improved energy management systems and improved awareness
- Achieve a reduction of gas consumption through improved energy management systems and improved awareness
- Achieve a reduction of water consumption through installation of flow reducing devices and improved awareness
- Achieve a reduction in energy through investment in compact fluorescent lamps as replacements for Dichroic Halogen lamps
- Establish a Green Team in the hotel to drive Carbon Reduction through implementation of energy saving initiatives.
