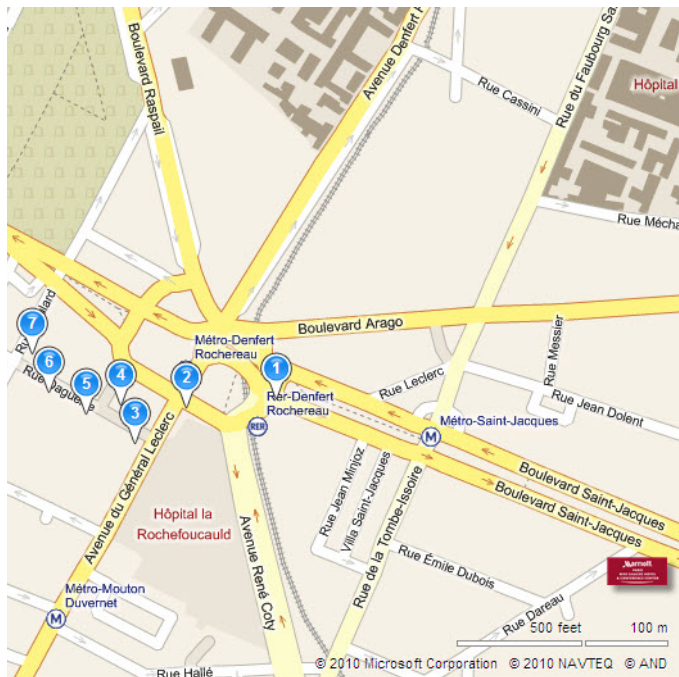


## POWER TRIP A Parisian Stroll

❶ First a note of history ~ Daguerre stands for daguerreotype, the invention of putting photographs on paper, invented by Jacques Daguerre in 1863. Now onto our stroll .....

Exit the Hotel to your left, walk for 15 minutes, you will be at the traffic circle. Cross the street to the park and the Catacomes, Open 10 to 4 closed on Tuesdays

❷ Follow the traffic circle to the left, at the second street, you will find Indiana Café 1 Avenue du Général Leclerc, then cross the street and turn left then right.

❸ Monoprix, grocery store, 8 Ave du Général Leclerc

❹ Maison Peret, wine bar & store and a good bistro. 6 Rue Daguerre ~ Just across the street is Vacroux, a

very famous cheese shop open daily except Monday

❺ Pharmacy, Dinton, on the left after the fish market 11 Rue Daguerre Open Daily

❻ Amorino ice cream parlor, for fantastic Italian gelato. 17 Rue Daguerre

❼ Café d'enfert lovely French restaurant open daily, closed Sunday evenings, try the Plat du Jour and 'le petit denfert' for dessert 22 Rue Daguerre

❽ At the end of Rue Daguerre is an Italian Restaurant, La Forchetta – the fork, great for families! 85 Rue Daguerre
