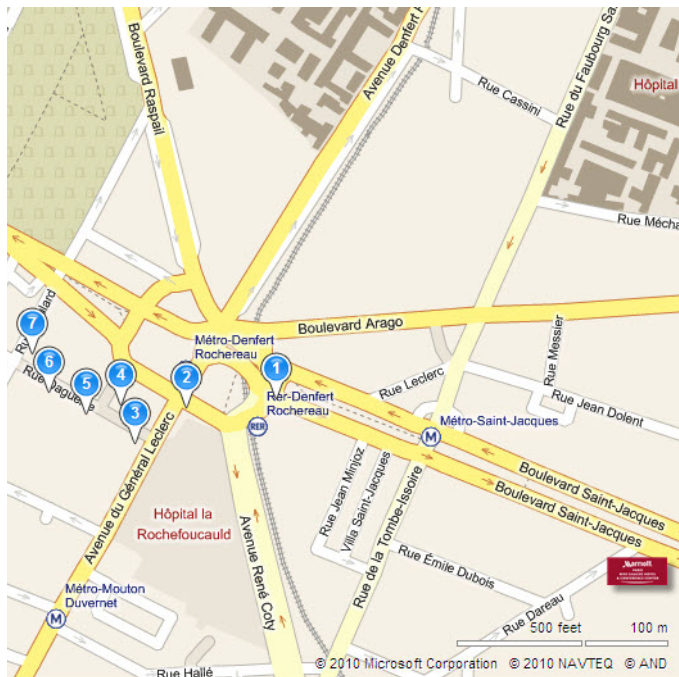


POWER TRIP

- ➊ Rue Daguerre is a lively traditional Parisian street. Turn left out the hotel and it is approximately 15 minute walk up to the round-about Denfert Rochereau. When you arrive at the round-about if you cross the street, there is a small park and most importantly the Catacombes (an underground 18th century cemetery), open daily from 10 to 4 except Tuesdays.
- ➋ For Rue Daguerre follow the round-about to the left at the second street, you will find Indiana Café, cross the street and turn left, then right.
- ➌ At the corner of Rue Daguerre and Ave Général Leclerc is a grocery store Monoprix
- ➍ At 6 Rue Daguerre is Maison Peret, a wine bar & store as well as good bistro across the street is Vacroux, a very famous cheese shop.
- ➎ The Dinton pharmacy is at 11 Rue Daguerre
- ➏ A few more doors down is Amorino ice cream parlor, for a great Italian gelato.
- ➐ Continuing down Rue Daguerre is Café d'enfert a lovely French restaurant for lunch & dinner closed Sunday evenings, try the Plat du Jour and 'le petit denfert' for dessert.
- ➑ At the end of Rue Daguerre is Italian Restaurant, La Forchetta – the fork, great for families.
