After graduating from the city's Le Cordon Bleu College of Culinary Arts, Verdo stayed in the Boston area to pursue his career. In 2011, he served as sous chef for the French brasserie Miel at the Intercontinental Hotel in Boston. From there, Verdo moved on to Asana at the Mandarin Oriental Hotel, spending two years as sous chef at the AAA Five Diamond and Forbes Five Star property. Most recently, Chef Verdo made his mark as executive chef at CHOPPS American Bar and Grill at the Boston Marriott Burlington, where his focus on exceeding guests' expectations was widely recognized. He worked under Daniel Bruce, who has been honored twice as one of the "Best Hotel Chefs in America" at the James Beard House.

Verdo describes his cooking style as progressive American cuisine; a reflection of the diversity that characterizes the country itself. He values exceptional, regional ingredients and inventive techniques to create his melting pot of dishes.

Throughout his career as a chef, Verdo's passion for what he does has evolved from a basic love for cooking to a love for being in the kitchen: the adrenaline rush during service, creating new dishes and seeing the reaction from satisfied customers. When he's not in the kitchen, Chef Verdo can be found with his wife Nicole and two children, enjoying outdoor activities and cooking for Sunday football games.
