- Exit from the Phuket Airport and turn right.
- Go approximately 1 km, and turn left at the first intersection onto highway 4026.
- Drive 4 km to the next major intersection, and turn left (heading north) at the traffic lights onto highway 402.
- Drive north for 13 km (past Blue Canyon Golf Course), and turn left at the JW Marriott sign.
- Proceed straight with the road and Renaissance Phuket Resort and Spa will be on the right hand side

## FROM SOMEONE WHO KNOWS

- 1 **Sea Kayaking** – If you've never tried it, this is the time, and if you're a fan, this is the place. Phang Nga Bay, and its spectacular tidal sea caves and hongs ("rooms" in Thai) with their towering rock walls, sky blue ceilings, and plethora of plant and animal life, is especially dramatic (and romantic) at sunset, when our Hong by Starlight tour begins.
- 2 **Chalong Temple** – Located about 8km from Phuket Town, Phuket's most famous temple has been extending a warm welcome to visitors for over a century as well as helping them to better understand the kingdom's predominant religion. A recent addition is the 61.4-meter high chedi containing the Phra Borom Sareerikatat relic, a fragment of the Lord Buddha's bones.
- 3 **Blue Canyon Country Club** – One of the most prestigious golfing establishments in the region. Blue Canyon is cradled in a verdant 720-acre valley against a magnificent backdrop of the Phang Nga Mountains and the Andaman Sea, and offers two award-winning championship courses.
- 4 **Similan Islands** – You've come this far – don't leave without seeing the Similans. These nine uninhabited islands offer some of the best scenery in Thailand as well as world renowned diving and snorkeling. With their amazing variety of marine life, the Similans offer a rare opportunity to see endangered species up close and personal.
- 5 **Weekend Market** – One of the best kept shopping secrets on the island is the large weekend market on the outskirts of Phuket Town. Looking for souvenirs, clothing and accessories, or home decorations. It's all here, along with an abundance of delicious local food.
