JW Marriott Tucson Starr Pass Resort and Spa

- Land Preservation: Resort donated 150 acres of pristine Sonoran desert to the Tucson Mountain Park at opening (2005)
- Environmental Enhancement Fund: Allocating a percentage of sales to research on mountain lions, trailheads and signage in Tucson Mountain Park and controlling of buffelgrass.
- Used Recycled Fill: No foreign soil was ever brought into the resort during the building of the property.
- Wash Preservation: All washes were preserved to allow free flow of water sources from the upper desert to lower desert thus fulfilling our commitment to allow aquifers to be replenished and to preserve the natural highways for desert animals.
- Winter Water Plan: Starr Pass Golf Club only over seeds fairways and tees to conserve millions of gallons of water each year.
- Reclaimed Water: All golf course irrigation is reclaimed water. In addition, Primo Restaurant collects rain water to supplement watering in their organic garden.
- The Banquet Department and most outlets are committed to buying organic food before non-organic when available.
- Meat Product: Resort purchases humanely treated animals free of any additional hormones or antibiotics when available.
- Sustainable Produce: The resort works closely with the Agua Linda CSA and Sleeping Frog Farms (organic and sustainable agriculture free of any GMO or use of engineered seed crops) for most of our produce needs.
- Xeriscape: 95% of property left in original state of the Sonoran Desert which contributes to low water landscaping.
- Line Caught Fish: We refer to Monterey Bay Aquariums West Coast seafood guide to ensure we are supporting well managed fisheries and contributing to healthy ocean wildlife.
- On-Site Garden: Resort maintains an organic garden that is cultivated and items are used for Primo meals and functions.
- Linen Program: Bed linens are changed every 3 days unless otherwise requested by our guests.
- Recycle Newspaper: All newspapers are recycled.
- Recycle Paper: Every department participates in the paper recycling program.
- Recycle Cups: Plastic cups in the lobby have been replaced with cups made from recyclable materials.
